Therapists at the Centre provide individual therapy to adult (over age 16 years) survivors of recent and historic sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse. The candidate will provide consultation to four therapists for up to two hours each per month. Renumeration based in accordance with current private practice hourly rates.

- To have a minimum of a Masters' degree in Social Work, Counselling or Clinical Psychology
- To be in good standing with a professional association and to hold professional liability insurance
- To have experience in providing consultation support

- To be aware of ethical issues and responsibilities in a therapeutic relationship
- To have experience/knowledge with a broad spectrum of therapeutic approaches
- To have knowledge and skills in trauma informed therapy and working with complex trauma
- To have knowledge about vicarious trauma
- To have knowledge about issues of transference and counter transference in the therapeutic relationship
- To have an understanding of issues of healing for survivors
- To have an understanding of the impacts of sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse on individuals, families and communities
- To have an understanding of social/cultural dynamics contributing to sexual violence
