The Centre offers therapeutic services to adult and youth (over age 16) survivors of recent and historic sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse, and works in partnership with other community groups in sexual violence prevention initiatives.

1. TRAUMA THERAPIST

In collaboration with other team members, the candidate will be responsible for providing intake and individual therapeutic services. The preferred candidate will have a Masters' degree in Social Work, Counselling or Clinical Psychology and several years of counselling experience. The following will also be important:

- Understanding of issues in healing for survivors of sexual violence
- An understanding of the impacts of sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse on individuals, families and communities
- Understanding of social/cultural dynamics contributing to sexual violence

- A demonstrated ability to work collaboratively as part of a team

2. INTAKE TRAUMA COUNSELLOR

In collaboration with other team members, the candidate will be responsible for responding to requests for counselling, arranging and conducting intake interviews, and providing counseling for survivors of recent sexual assault. This position may also include other tasks such as preparing resource materials, writing project proposals and other administrative tasks. The preferred candidate will have a degree in Social Work, Counselling or Clinical Psychology and some counselling experience. The following will also be important:
