ABOUT PEI RAPE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT CENTRE

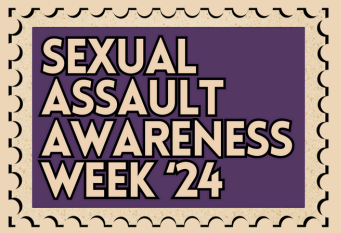
We are a non-profit, government-funded organization that provides services to individuals of all genders residing in PEI who have experienced recent or historic sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse.

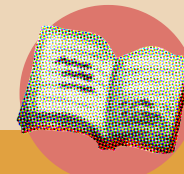
